
Chestnut or acorn spider webs

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Chestnuts or acorns
- Wooden skewers

- A little chesnut<u>hand drill</u> (Or any sharp tool like pointy scissors to make a little hole in the chestnuts)
- Yarn
- Scissors

METHOD:

With the chesnut drill, make 5 evenly spread out holes in the chesnut (adult supervision required here). Push the skewers in the holes so they are tightly inserted. Choose a yarn to start with. With a flat knot, secure the yarn around one of the skewers. Start weaving by twisting around each skewer before you go to the next one.

If you want to start a new colour, just knot the yarn around a skewer to secure it, and tie the new colour to the next skewer. Keep going until you're happy. Done!
